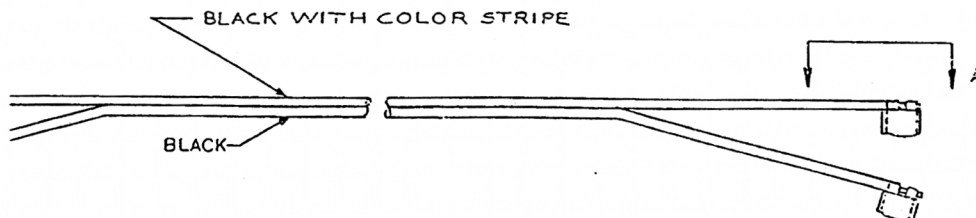
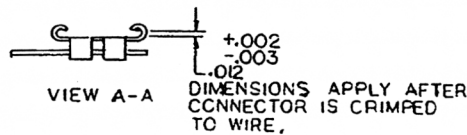

The Black (with color stripe) lead is connected to GND, and connects to the minus (-) transducer connection.
